Dr. Swager received a B.S. from Montana State University and a Ph.D. from the California Institute of Technology. After a postdoctoral appointment at MIT, he was on the chemistry faculty at the University of Pennsylvania and returned to MIT in 1996 as a professor of Chemistry and served as the Head of Chemistry from 2005-2010.

Dr. Swager has published more than 500 peer-reviewed publications and more than 120 issued/pending patents. His honors include: Election to the National Academy of Sciences, an Honorary Doctorate from Montana State University, National Academy of Investors Fellow, The Pauling Medal, The Lemelson-MIT Award for Invention and Innovation, Election to the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, The American Chemical Society Award for Creative Invention The American Chemical Society Award in Polymer Chemistry, The Christopher Columbus Foundation Homeland Security Award, and The Carl S. Marvel Creative Polymer Chemistry Award. Dr. Swager has founded five companies and has served on several corporate and government boards.
